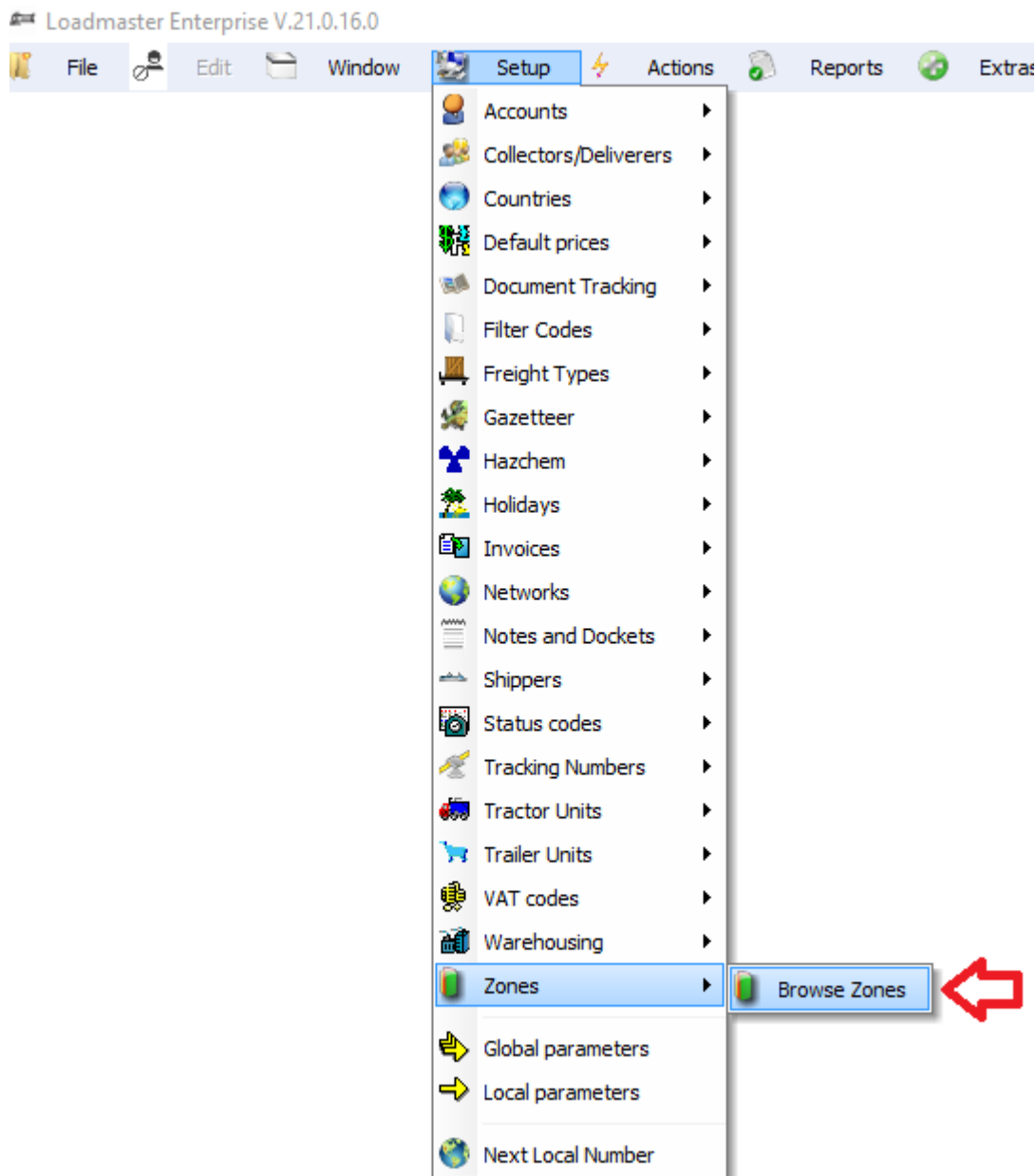


This deals with a company using 160 distinct pricing zones. Most are a lot less.

I would suggest that you first create these zones in Loadmaster. I started the main block at Zone 21 so that they didn't interfere with any they had already set. The zones allow you to set up different prices to different areas. Zone 1 is always your local area, so at the end you set ALL your postcodes to zone 1.

I worked out the zones from the pricing rates sent to me.

Use this option to update Zones –

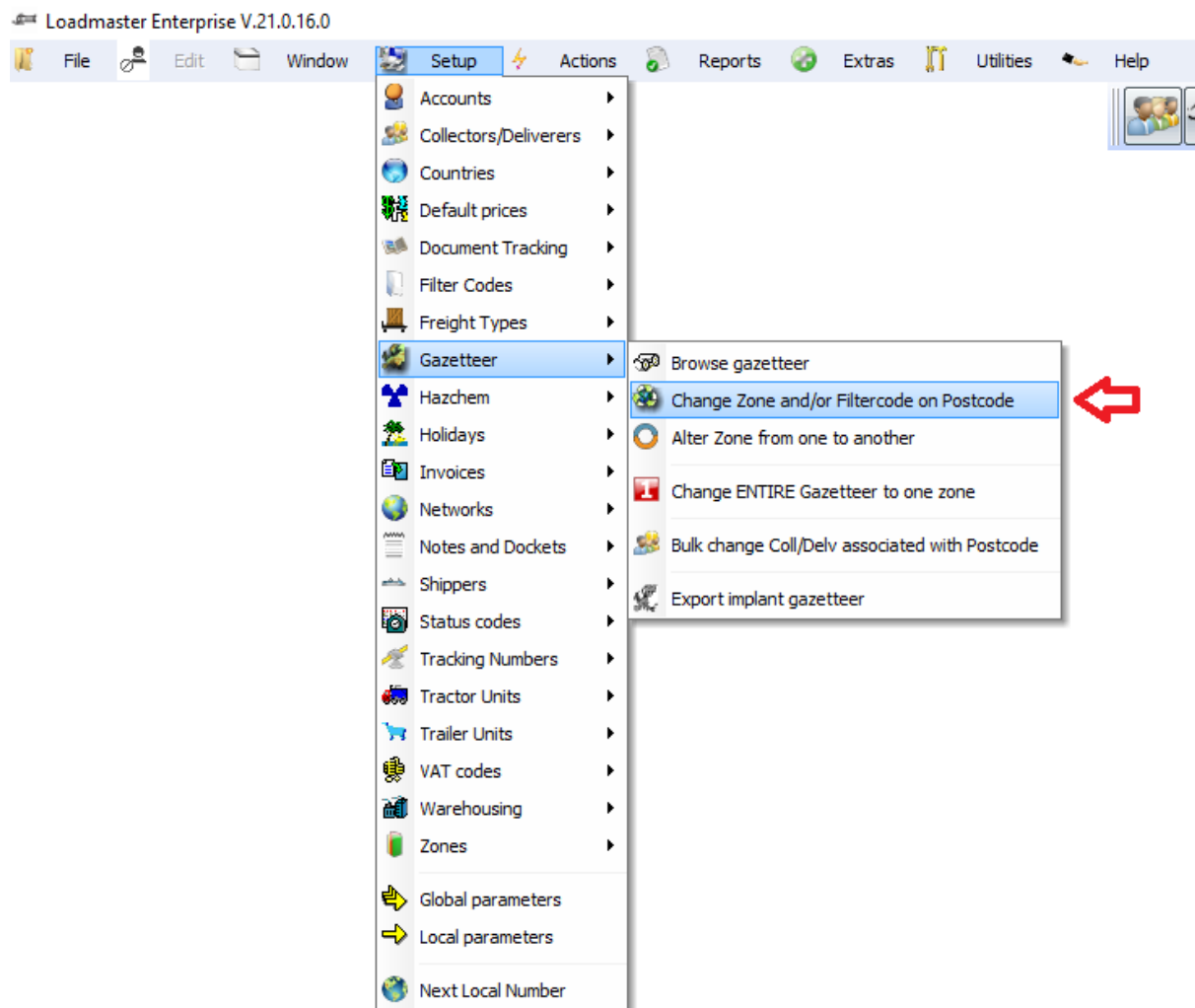

After the zones are created they need linking to the Gazetteer using this option –





This updates a single postcode area –

Alter Gazetteer Zone and/or Filtercode

Main Postcode: AB  Tick to do all postcodes 0 - 99 and untick for exact match Change ↻

Sub Part: 10  Confirm to update just this part. Overrides above option Close ✖

Set to Zone: 21  AB10-16,21-25,30,39  Do it

This updates a complete postcode area (AL0 – AL99 here) and links it to a zone –

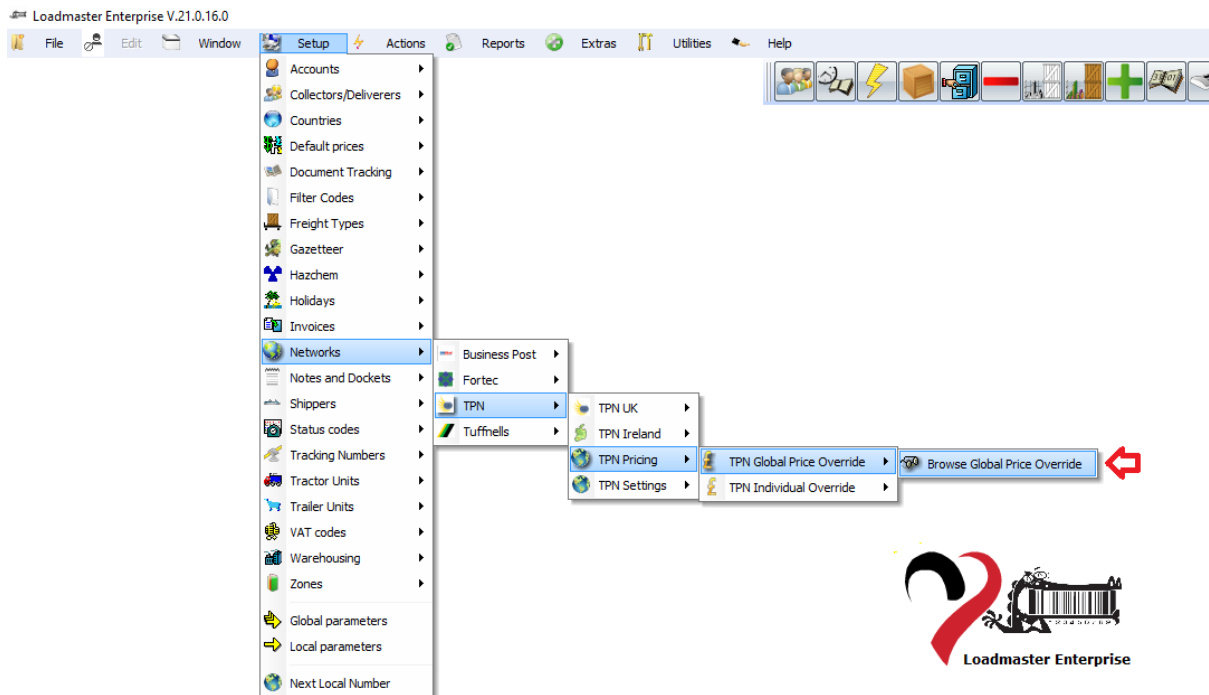
Sub Part:  Confirm to update just this part. Overrides above option Close ✖

Where a postcode area is split between two or more zones then you set the largest one to the complete postcode and then do the smaller bits individually. So you could set all of AB to zone 21 then update the smaller sections to 22.

Once the Zones and Gazetteer are set you then need to work out which of your pricing systems is commonly used. To use a TPN pricing scheme it needs setting up using this option –



TPN jobs will then use this option instead of normal pricing. You only enter services that you offer.

The TPN Price Override will only update prices where the rate has been entered, otherwise it will fall back to standard pricing.

To have customers on different rates you use TPN Unique Price Override. It will use these first if they exist.

If a customer has the TPN Unique Price Override set then it will use this first. If it doesn't exist then it will fall back to the TPN Price Override. If that doesn't exist then it will fall back to the pricing defaults.

TPN PRICING – COMPLEX EXAMPLE

This is setting a ND service from Zone 1 (local) to Zone 21.

SPAWNING mass replicates an existing rate to another set of services in the same zone. This bulk updates a series of services that you select. It will open a new window to select these. **Spawn**

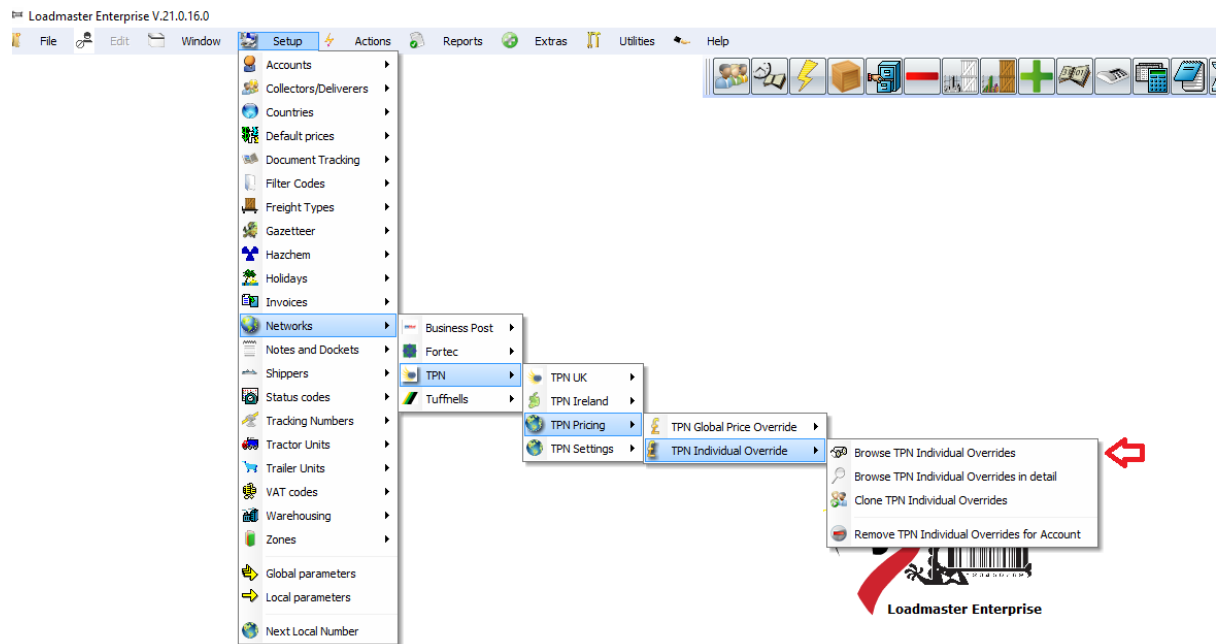

To replicate the charges from one zone to another then pick an existing rate and put a value in this 'To' Zone box then hit CLONE      
*If you find another zone is using the same pricing you can simply CLONE it*

To replicate the charges from one service to another then pick an existing rate and put a value in this 'Service' box then hit CLONE      
*If other services to the same zone are the same price you can CLONE it*

SPAWNING mass replicates an existing rate to another set of services in the same zone.    
*Mass duplicates the prices to other services in the same zone*

You set individual rates using TPN Unique Pricing Overrides –

To replicate the charges from one zone to another pick an existing rate and put a value in this To Zone box then hit CLONE

SPAWNING mass replicates an existing rate to another set of services in the same zone for the same customer. This bulk updates a series of services that you select. A new window will open where you can select these.

Once you have the major set of prices set up using TPN Pricing Override then you only need to set up one complete set of alternative pricing on a customer and then Clone it to others.

Probably the easiest way to set up as quickly as possible is to create a set of ‘dummy’ accounts (e.g. dummy1, dummy2, dummy3 etc) that are completely set up - then set these accounts to DO NOT INVOICE.

You then copy these rates using Clone.
