

Loadmaster Pickups

This appears in this section of the program -




There are 42 routes and you need to supply basic information on those in use. They need a name, for example, so that the user can quickly understand how things are set up.

Initially go into View/Update Pickup Data by Vehicle. This will be blank.




Click on the route you wish to use and enter the basic detail.




The basic details consist of Vehicle, Registration and Driver. Save this.

To enter a pickup choose New and Allocated Pickups. Initially this will be blank. Here is an example with one pickup entered. To add a pickup click on New. To modify click on Modify or double-click on the items.



Complete the basic details.




To leave unallocated do not click on an entry in the Route box. This can be done later.

To allocate double-click on the associated Route on the Route box.

Once allocated it no longer appears in the New and Allocated Pickups. It appears in the View/Allocate all Pickups from where it can be unallocated.

You can view everything for a particular Route by choosing View/Update Pickup Data by Vehicle.



You can also view a real-time version by clicking on the appropriate Real-Time View. This updates every 10 seconds.

Note the colour coding.

Highlighting a customer means Trailer Swap. Underlining means collected.

Highlighting a driver means Driver Informed.

You can clear entries after they have been collected by bringing up the detailed Route and choosing Scratch/Remove at the bottom. You enter the associated row number and then hit either of these options. Scratch just removes the entry. Remove takes it out and does a resequence of the display, moving items up the list. You MUST still SAVE at the end.

You can also mark items as collected so they colour change in the Real-Time display.

To clear the data out use the Pickup Maintenance option. You can clear all the data or just the pickups (note that daily pickups are left to be allocated again).
